Following the Hospital Follow Up exam, your baby's next regular Check Up will be at 1 month of age.

LAB TESTS

1. Metabolic Screening including PKU (Phenylketonuria), Galactosemia, Thyroid function and 26 other conditions is performed on all babies after they are 24 hours old. We will review the results of these tests at their one month visit. If any of these results are abnormal, we will notify you.
2. Jaundice: If your baby is jaundiced at discharge, you might be asked to return to the Outpatient Lab at the hospital for a follow up lab test.

SAFE RIDE HOME

Be sure your infant seat is installed properly, and your infant is safely secured for the first ride home. All other passengers should also be properly restrained. Your first few days and nights will be a time of adjustment for your baby as well as for you. Try to take it easy, limit visitors and overexhausting activities. Settle into your with the baby as calmly and confidently as possible. Babies are wonderful people! They need you to fall in love with them, and to learn how to recognize their cries for food, warmth and comfort. As the days pass, you will grow in your ability to recognize and meet their needs.
